

Academic partnership agreement between University of East London (UEL) and Cairo University.

Overview.

University of East London (UEL) has entered into a partnership agreement with Cairo University in 2023 to launch an academic program within the framework of the National Strategy for Higher Education and Scientific Research 2030; the program will be applied at Cairo University International branch at Sixth of October City. This program is the first international program that Egyptian students can access in the international branch of Cairo University.

The partnership is therefore construed as a dual award partnership whereby students will receive an award from both UEL and Cairo University upon successful completion of their programme of study. This program is international credit hours system, which align with FOC CU credit hours system. The student must follow the sequence of modules for program study plan

➤ **WHAT IS the University of East London (EUL)?**

1. The accounting and finance degree provides perfect academic credentials and will fast-track you on a path to becoming a qualified accountant.
2. Enrolling in this accounting degree offers a comprehensive pathway to a successful career in finance, equipping you with the necessary academic credentials to help you on your journey to becoming a qualified accountant.
3. The Banking and Finance degree aims to give you a rigorous grounding in the core concepts, knowledge and skills of banking and finance through the thorough examination of the specialist literature in these areas and the practical use of data collection and analysis.
4. The programme content is closely mapped to the Chartered Institute for Securities and Investment (CISI) and plans to get the accreditation.

UEL/CU admits highly qualified applicants who complete and fulfil the admission requirements.

➤ **Minimum Admission Requirements**

To be admitted, students should provide certificates showing:

- Completion of the Egyptian high school certificate (**Thanawiya Amma**) - science, math or arts, the minimum GPA or total percentage differs for each academic year.
- International General Certificate of Secondary Education (IGCSE) American Diploma.
- Or equivalent certificates from national and international students with appropriate entry requirements.
- Accepted, in accordance to Tanseeq (ranking) office, to be admitted to Faculty of Commerce for the academic year.
- In addition to the academic requirements of the course, A minimum overall IELTS score of 5.5 with the exception of those with English Language Grade C or above at Singapore/Cambridge as long as their application form demonstrates the required level of competence in English.
