A. General Information

Brief Description of Institution

Cairo University is a comprehensive institution of higher education located in Giza, Egypt. CU Mission Statement: Excellence in providing higher education services to meet the needs of the national, regional and international communities, and the effective continuous contribution in achieving Egypt's social and economic development.

Our mission is to be accomplished through a commitment to international standards of excellence in the fields of education, research and community service, as well as the integration of personnel, technology and business systems, and the development of the university's human resources.

It was established in 1908; currently it has 26 faculties/institutions in different scientific disciplines, with a total volume of about 230000 students; they are:

Faculty of Engineering, Faculty of Medicine, Faculty of Computers and Information System, Faculty of Pharmacy, Faculty of Agriculture, Faculty of Science, Faculty of Economics and Political Science, Faculty of Mass Communication, Faculty of Archaeology, Faculty of Arts, Faculty of Commerce, Faculty of Specialized Education, Faculty of Nursing, Faculty of Law, Faculty of Physiotherapy, Faculty of Oral and Dental Medicine, Faculty of Veterinary Medicine, Faculty of Dar ElUlum (Linguistic; Arabic), Faculty of Education for Early Childhood Faculty of Regional and Urban Planning, Center of Open Education, Institute of Statistical Studies and Research, Institute of African Studies and Research, Faculty of Graduate Studies for Education, National Institute of Laser Enhanced Sciences, and National Cancer Institute. The first 21 of them offer undergraduate and postgraduate studies, while the last five is stands for the postgraduate studies only.

This category excludes PhD Students, Administrative Staff, Technical Staff, Laboratory technicians, Research Assistants, Librarians, Adjunct Professors, Visiting Scholars.

-B1.1.3 Of which are research only

refers to the headcount number of full-time academic staff who are assigned research responsibilities only during the reporting year. This category may include Research Professors, Research Associate Professors, Research Assistant Professors, Research Fellows, Research Associates, Research Scientists, Postdoctoral Fellows, or equivalent academic positions. This category excludes PhD Students, Administrative Staff, Technical Staff, Laboratory technicians, Research Assistants, Librarians, Adjunct Professors, Visiting Scholars.

-B1.1.4 Of which are international staff

refers to the headcount number of full-time academic staff who do not hold the nationality of the country where the institution is located.

-D1.1 Total Institutional Income

-D1.1.1 Of which was derived from governmental appropriations

refers to the governmental appropriations provided to the institution by national or local government authorities, including central government funding, local government funding, earmarked appropriations, and non-research project-based appropriations.

-D1.1.2 Of which was derived from student tuition and fees

refers to the charges levied by the institution for educational services provided to students or other learners, including tuition fees for degree programs at the undergraduate, master's, and doctoral levels; fees for continuing education and vocational training; admission or application fees; examination fees; and other student-related charges.

-D1.1.3 Of which was derived from research activities

refers to the income generated by the institution from research activities and related support activities, including governmental research grants, industry-sponsored research funding, revenues from research contracts, technical service fees, and other research-related income.

-D1.1.4 Of which was derived from donations and endowments

refers to funds received by the institution or institutional endowment from individuals, corporations, foundations, alumni organizations, or other external entities, with no restrictions or only limited restrictions on their use. This excludes revenues from investments of endowment funds.

-D1.1.5 Of which was derived from self-operating activities and investments

refers to the revenues generated by the institution through self-operating activities, service provision, investments (including investments of endowment funds), and the management or utilization of institutional assets. This category includes revenue from auxiliary services (housing, dining, and student health services) and intellectual property licensing (royalties, trademarks and patents), as well as returns on assets such as interest, dividends and rent. This excludes revenues generated by affiliated or majority-owned entities that operate as independent legal structures, such as the operating revenues of affiliated hospitals and the consolidated earnings of wholly-owned or majority-owned subsidiaries.

-D1.2 Income of Affiliated Entities

refers to the revenues generated by the institution's affiliated or majority-owned entities that operate as independent legal structures. This includes the operating revenues of affiliated hospitals and the consolidated earnings of wholly-owned or majority-owned subsidiaries.
