

11.2 Support of arts and heritage

11.2.1 CU as a body provides public access to buildings, monuments or natural heritage landscapes of cultural significance.

There is documentation to Cairo University indicating that all its campus buildings, monuments or “natural heritage landscapes” of cultural significance are formally open to general public access:

- 1- **The 1st evidence** is about the dome and clock tower of Cairo University have recently been officially declared historical monuments by the Ministry of Tourism and Antiquities of Egypt.
- 2- **The 2nd evidence** is a press release about the university museum which houses treasures over 116 years old, including the chair of King Fuad I, the desk of King Farouk, the foundation document of the university, a model of the university’s ibis “أبو منجل” emblem, and other historic artefacts.
- 3- **The 3rd. evidence** is about the “Book Fair” held in the new Central Library premises: “In 2024, the university’s new central library hosted a large-book-fair 25 Feb–7 Mar ...”
- 4- **The 4th. evidence** is the official page of the CU New Central Library including instructions to visitors.
