

12.2 Operational measures

12.2.4 CU as a body has a policy on waste disposal - To measure the amount of waste sent to landfill and recycled.

CU has evidence of practices consistent with measuring waste volumes (including recycling and disposal):

- 1- **The 1 st evidence** is CU's **Sustainability Report 2024** includes In CU's 2024 Sustainability Report, it states: "The total organic waste generated by Cairo University amounted to approximately 526.49 tonnes in 2024, a decrease from 675.96 tonnes in 2023." This shows CU is measuring at least one category of waste (organic) and tracking year-on-year changes. P. 22-24
- The report discusses "Waste - Minimization and Diversion; Construction & Demolition Waste; Hazardous Waste Management" as categories. This implies that CU is tracking hazardous waste and has a system in place for its management.
- 2- **The 2 nd evidence** is In **the 2023 Sustainability Report**, CU presents a "3R programme (Reduce, Reuse, Recycle)" and describes efforts to minimize waste and divert it away from disposal, referencing both recycling and landfill/disposal.p. 30-32.
