

12.3 Proportion of recycled waste

12.3.1 CU as a body measure the amount of waste generated and recycled across the university.

Cairo University does measure the amount of waste generated and recycled across the university, according to its official Sustainability Reports:

- 1- **The 1 st evidence** is the sustainability report 2023 of CU, The report explicitly states that the **university** measures total waste produced and the share diverted for recycling or reuse. Pages: 30–32.
- 2- **The 2 nd evidence** is Cairo University Sustainability Report 2024, The report provides updated quantitative data: “The total organic waste generated by Cairo University amounted to approximately **526.49 tonnes in 2024**, compared with **675.96 tonnes in 2023** — reflecting an improvement in waste reduction and recycling management.” Pages: 22–24.
