1.3.2 Cairo University has targets to complete the graduation for students who fall into the bottom 20% of household income

The university has a general commitment to ensuring "quality, equitable and inclusive education" and offers scholarships and financial aid to "needy students," this is implicitly mentioning targeted graduation rates for a low-income quintile. Cairo University is a public University and offers education for all who is eligible according to the Egyptian university admissions system for high school graduates and offers full and partial scholarships for students in need through the administration of solidarity of CU (Takaful Office)
