

3.3 Collaborations and health services

3.3.4 – Evidence that CU provides students access to sexual and reproductive health-care services including information and education services

Cairo University has a comprehensive network of hospitals for students and the general public, including the main **El Qasr El Ainy Hospital** with its many specialized departments, as well as smaller student-specific facilities like **the Student Hospital** in Giza. The university's hospitals are equipped for both general and specialized medical care and are connected to medical schools, serving as a primary center for healthcare and medical training in Egypt.

Main teaching hospitals

- **El Qasr El Ainy Hospital**: The main and largest hospital complex, it includes specialized departments for internal medicine, surgery, and other fields. The New Educational Hospital has 1,200 beds and is equipped with advanced medical equipment.
- **El Manial Academic Hospital**: One of the main teaching hospitals affiliated with the university.
- **El Qasr El Ainy Medical School**: This is the parent institution for many of the university's hospitals, established in 1827.

Specialized and student-focused hospitals

- **Student Hospital (Giza)**: This hospital specifically provides medical support to students, employees, and the general public. It has a significant number of beds and facilities for patient care, including inpatient beds and ICU beds.
- **Obstetrics and Gynecology Hospital**: A specialized hospital focusing on women's health.
- **Internal Medicine Hospital**: This is a specialized hospital for internal medicine cases.
- **Pediatrics New Academic Hospital**: A specialized hospital for pediatric cases.
- **External Clinic**: The university also has external clinics available for students and staff.

Access and services

- **Free and paid services**: The Student Hospital offers services for free to students and employees and also treats the general public for a fee.
- **Specialized care**: The hospitals are equipped to handle a wide range of medical conditions, including general and specialized surgeries, internal medicine, and pediatrics.
- **IT system**: A new IT system has been implemented at the Student Hospital to enhance efficiency, streamline operations, and improve patient care.

All of the above medical services, including sexual and reproductive health-care services, is provided to CU students for free. As for the Knowledge and awareness, CU assesses it and provide it through many pathways:

- **Symposiums**

- **Medical Convoys** (including a component for raising RH awareness)
- **Researches and Studies** aim to evaluate the learning outcomes of students from the redesigned e-learning version of the reproductive health section in the public health curriculum, measured by improved acquisition of knowledge and opinions, and to assess the use of the e-learning curriculum.
