

5.3 Student access measures

5.3.3 CU provides women's access schemes (e.g. mentoring, scholarships, or other provisions).

Cairo University provides women-specific access schemes (mentoring, scholarships, and other provisions):

- The 1st piece of evidence, is **the report of the Women's Center at the Faculty of Mass communication 2022-2024**, Cairo University
- The 2nd piece of evidence is a **press release** referring to an awareness seminar on the role of media in activating women's community participation.
- The 3rd piece of evidence is a **press release** referring to CU has a partnership in the project “British Council – Violence Against Women & Girls Free Campuses” working with CU’s Anti-Harassment unit. This indicates a commitment to supporting female students’ safe participation in the university.
- The 4th piece of evidence is a **programme called “Pathways-Egypt”**, hosted by CU’s Center for Advancement of Post Graduate Studies and Research in Engineering Sciences (CAPSCU) touches student skills/training and is open to “students and graduates” for enhanced opportunities.
