Program Eligibility Criteria:

Applicants who wish to apply for the scholarship must meet the following criteria:

- Egyptian citizen with no dual nationality
- A minimum score of 490 on the ITP TOEFL exam
- Must be enrolled in freshman year of university working toward a Bachelor's degree at the time of application
- Interested in studying agriculture and willing to contribute to the Egyptian agricultural development
- Engaged in community services and extracurricular activities
- Planning to come back to Egypt after completing the undergraduate program
- Fulfilling academic excellence in the following subjects :

Math;

- Science (Physical and Chemistry)
- English Languages;
- and Two other subjects, from: Biology, Geography, Accounting, History or others.
- Achieving grade level of 85%-90% in Thanweya Amma or its equivalency in any education system
- American Diploma, GPA: 3.0-3.5
- SAT I score: 1800 or above
- IGSCE students must score straight A's
